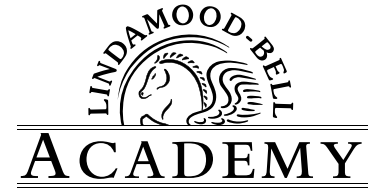


Academy Magic Newsletter

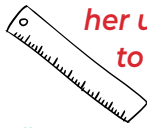
Students are getting the differentiated instruction they have been waiting for provided by expert staff who are so passionate about pursuing a magical experience for all our students.

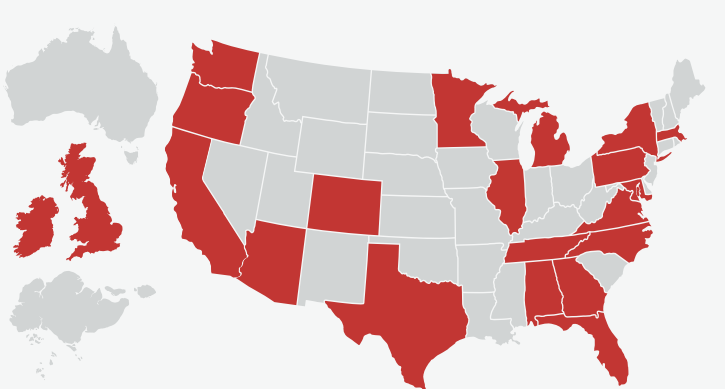
There are lots of "firsts" in Academy! The first time feeling safe at school, first time making friends, first time understanding curriculum, first time feeling successful in school...the list goes on!



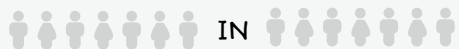
