Familiarize yourself with technology:
☐ Screen share

☐ Whiteboard features
Have your materials ready:  Log into any digital resources Have printed materials ready Lesson plan and instructional notes available
Establish Extrinsic Motivators:
☐ Immediate rewards for responses
Rewards for attending as others think/work
Rewards for overall attention/participation at halfway and endpoint of the lesson
Set the climate for the lesson:
☐ What students will be learning
Why students want to learn it
How students are expected to participate:
<ul><li>Use of hand gestures – Raising your hand, Thumbs up or down</li><li>Features built into the VC platform</li><li>Other:</li></ul>
Explanation of how extrinsic motivators will be provided
During the lesson:
Positive reinforcement on participation and attention
Students accessing imagery by looking up or gesturing
Popcorn questioning – Keep students engaged by rotating questions that challenge, yet are attainable for students' level.
Choral responses elicit engagement from all students
Consider how the energy of lesson drives engagement
Incorporate movement and multisensory activities
☐ Involve students in the learning process through Socratic questioning
Utilize meta-cognitive activities
After the lesson:
Aligned documentation – Meticulous note-taking will help maintain consistent record-keeping and can be used as a formative asessment to help guide instruction. The use of digital record-keeping helps all stakeholders stay informed.
