Lindamood Phoneme Sequencing Program for Reading, Spelling, and Speech (LiPS) Formerly Auditory Discrimination in Depth (A.D.D.)

The Lindamood Phoneme Sequencing[®] (LiPS[®]) program, by Pat Lindamood and Phyllis Lindamood, develops phonemic awareness, reading, spelling, and speech. Students discover the articulatory features of each phoneme to verify the number, order, and identity of sounds within words.

Students/setting: struggling readers with specific difficulties in phoneme awareness and speech, dyslexia, RTI/MTSS, intervention, high-impact tutoring

Staff: Speech and language pathologists, resource/special education staff, dyslexia specialists, reading interventionists, paraprofessionals, tutors

Grade Levels: PreK - 12 (Tier 2 & 3, Special Education)

Group size: 5-8 (Tier 2), 5 or fewer (Tier 3, Special Education)

Lessons: 30-45 minutes (Tier 2), 60-120 minutes (Tier 3). 80-120 lessons*

*Lesson times are minimums. Some students may require more intensive intervention. Daily times and total lessons should be adjusted accordingly.

- Sensory-cognitive skills phonological awareness
 - Multisensory discovery of phonemes through auditory, articulatory, and visual processing
 - · Phoneme/grapheme manipulation, i.e., additions, deletions, substitutions, shifts
 - Blending
- Oral and written syllabication
- Components of reading letter/sound knowledge, phonics, decoding, spelling, word recognition, fluency
 Progression through skill development in essential decoding tasks
- Structured explicit, systematic, cumulative
 - Simple to complex, following scope and sequence
 - Teacher-led, Socratic questioning
- Diagnostic and prescriptive
 - Formative assessment
 - Differentiated instruction
- Application to connected text and writing
